Tour Highlights: Upon your arrival in Ulaanbaatar ``Genghis or Chinggis´´ New Airport (52 km/31.33 miles, 2 hrs driving, depending on the high traffic), meet Samar Magic Tours team. This unforgettable Mongolia journey designed especially for groups, families, private, and funny travel. Meeting nomadic people, staying in a traditional tent, seeing grasslands and beautiful vistas. Visit the 40 meter (~133, 3 feet) Statue of ``Genghis or Chinggis´´ Khaan, visitors walk to the head of the horse through its chest and neck of the horse, where they can have a panoramic view. The attached museum has exhibitions relating to the Bronze Age and Xiongnu archaeological cultures in Mongolia, which show everyday utensils, belt buckles, knives, sacred animals, etc. and a second exhibition on the Great Khan period in the 13 and 14th centuries which has ancient tools, goldsmith subjects and some Nestorian crosses and rosaries. Gorkhi/Terelj National Park-is one of the most popular national parks in Mongolia. Gorkhi/Terelj features stunning granite mountains and flowery endless grassy green meadows. This picturesque National Park is a part of Khan Khentii Strictly Protected Area. It is a great place for hiking, trekking, even you can rock climb here at its natural steep granite walls. Drive towards west to see the Authentic Mongol Nomad Show (will take place from 10:00AM-12:00M). It demonstrates traditional living way of real Mongolian nomads and breeding and using of five kinds of livestock and movement from one place to another using ox, yak, camel and horse carts which are the carts. Next, drive towards west to visit & explore Hustain Nuruu Wild Horses National Park (hustai is Mongolian for birch and nuruu means mountains) measures about 57,000 hectares, or including the buffer zone 120.000 ha., and is located on about 120kms/62 miles west from the capital Ulaanbaatar. The flagship species for the Hustain Nuruu Nature Reserve is the reintroduced Przewalski or takhi horse. Drive towards west to Elsen Tasarkhai (also know as Bayangobi desert)-is a part of the 80kms/50miles long Mongol Els Sand Dunes and is located on about 280kms west from the capital Ulaanbaatar. The nature in this area is really spectacular and great for relaxing. During the trip, you will also have opportunities to visit a local nomadic family. Enjoy ride two-humped Bactrian camel. Walk on sand dunes, experience staying in a traditional Mongolian dwelling ger, and walk and relax in beautifully serene nature. Enjoy the sunset!. We would be pleased to have you join us!.

Day 1-Upon your arrival in **Ulaanbaatar** ``**Genghis Khan**´´ **New Airport** (UB city), meet Samar Magic Tours team. Ulaanbaatar Grand City tour. **(L)**

Day 2-Ulaanbaatar-the 40meter/ \sim 133,3 feet Genghis Khan Statue-Gorkhi/Terelj National Park-Ulaanbaatar. **(B)(L)**

Day 3-Ulaanbaatar-Authentic Mongol Nomad Show-Hustain Nuruu National Park. (B)(L)(D)

Day 4-Hustain Nuruu National Park-Bayangobi Desert-Bactrian Camel riding-Khugnu Khan Peak Nature Reserve-Temple 'Uvgun'. **(B)(L)(D)**

Day 5-Bayangobi Desert-Ulaanbaatar. (B)(L)

Day 6-Departure Mongolia. (B)













DAY BY DAY ITINERARY:

Day 1-Upon your arrival in Ulaanbaatar `` Genghis Khan´´ New Airport and after custom formalities and baggage claim, you will be met by Samar Magic Tours team and taken to the centrally located hotel in Ulaanbaatar (by hotels policy the check-in time is after 02:00PM/14:00). Ulaanbaatar City tour: visit the Gandantegchinlen Monastery is a Tibetan-style Buddhist monastery that has been restored and revitalized since 1990. The Tibetan name translates to the "Great Place of Complete Joy". It currently has over 150 monks in residence. It features a 26.5-meter-high statue of Avalokitesvara. It came under state protection in 1994. 10:00AM-Here you will have the opportunity to attend a Buddhist ceremony. Next, we will visit a small museum of dinosaur fossils. The centerpiece of the museum is the 4m-tall, 3-ton ultraviolet Tarbosaurus bataar (cousin of Tyrannosaurus rex) and a smaller Saurolophus, with its distinctive cranial crest. The Tarbosaurus bataar made international headlines in 2012, when it sold for more than US\$1 million at an auction in Texas. The Mongolian Government protested that











the fossil had been illegally removed from Mongolia and demanded its return. The legal battle ended when a US judge ruled in favor of Mongolia. Nicolas Cage has agreed to return a rare dinosaur skull to the Mongolian government. The Oscar-winning actor bought the Tyrannosaurus bataar skull in 2007, not knowing it had been stolen. Authorities said he voluntarily agreed to hand over the skull after learning of the circumstances. The museum also includes examples of Velociraptor and Protoceratops, and a nest of Oviraptor eggs. It is located inside the former Lenin Museum, built in 1974. While there are plans to expand it into a world-class institution. Here you will see a large statue of the Genghis Khan-inaugurated in 2006 on the occasion of 800th Anniversary of the Great Mongolian Empire of Genghis Khan (1206-2006), the Sukh Baatar Hero along with The Parliament House, Stock Exchange, the Drama Theatre and the Palace of Culture. Visit the National History Museum-where you will see artefacts from Mongolia and Central Asia from the Stone Age to the present. Welcome lunch in traditional local restaurant. Next, we will visit the new museum "Genghis Khan" ("Chinggis Khaan"), which finally opened its doors on October 11, 2022. The museum is designed to show the history of the Mongol kings from the reign of the Hunnu king Modun Shanyu to the abdication of the Eighth Jebtsundamba. The Genghis (Chinggis) Khaan National Museum has been named one of the 20 must-visit museums by National Geographic. The "World's Best List" is compiled each year by the editors of National Geographic. The Genghis Khan National Museum was named one of the 20 best museums to visit this year. 06:00PM-Enjoy Mongolian Folk Song and dance show. Transfer to hotel. Overnight at selected and confirmed hotel. Dinner is not included. (L)















Day 2-Breakfast. 08:30AM-Meet Samar Magic Tours team at reception of the hotel. Drive towards to visit the 40 meter /~133,3 feet ``Genghis Khan´´ Statue on horseback (55km/34miles) N/E of the Mongolian capital Ulaanbaatar. The statue is symbolically pointed east towards his birthplace. It is on top of the Genghis Khan Statue Complex, a visitor center, itself 10 meters











(32 ft 10 in) tall, with 36 columns representing the 36 khans from **Genghis** to Ligdan Khan. Visitors walk to the head of the horse through its chest and neck of the horse, where they can have a panoramic view. Near the **Great Statue of Genghis Khan**, we can take beautiful photos with the **Kazakhs and their Golden Eagles**, **rides on the backs of Bactrian camels**, **or rides on Mongolian horses through the steppes**, **shooting with a bow and arrow** (***extra payment at the same place**). **Mongolian lunch on the route**. After, continuous drive north further to reach **Gorkhi/Terelj National Park**. Seeing grasslands and beautiful vistas. The valley is about 20kms/12miles long at 1600m. This picturesque National Park is a part of **Khan Khentii Strictly Protected Area**. It is a great place for hiking, trekking, even you can rock climb here at its natural steep granite walls. **Walking & Easy Trekking to the Turtle shaped original giant rock** - symbol of **Gorkhi/Terelj National Park**. **Drive back to Ulaanbaatar** (70km/44miles). Transfer to hotel. Overnight at selected and confirmed hotel. **Dinner is not included**. **(B)(L)**

Day 3-Breakfast. **08:00AM**-Meet Samar Magic Tours team at reception of the hotel. Drive towards west by comfortable 4WD vehicle to observe the **Authentic Mongol Nomad Show** (will take place from **10:00AM-12:00M**, about 35-40km/25miles, 1.30 hrs). It demonstrates traditional living way real Mongolian nomads and breeding and using of five kinds of livestock and movement from one place to another using ox, yak, camel and horse carts which are the carts. Here you will have the opportunity to hear a Mongolian folk song, to see 5 herding animals, to observe the demonstration of catching and milking sheep, goat, to observe the demonstration of making dairy products. Also, we will see the Mongolian archery, playing traditional games, the demonstration of making felt and tanning, the demonstration of moving one place to another use by cart, yak freight, camel and horse carts. Next, drive to **Hustain Nuruu National Park** (about 80km/50miles, 1.30 hrs) of the











Wild Horses Przewaslki or Takhi (as known by the Mongolians). The Takhi is the last species of wild horse left on the planet. In 1878, the Polish-born Russian geographer and naturalist Nikolai Mikhailovich Przewaslki found a new species of wild horse in Mongolia, known locally as Takhi, and took several foals to European zoos. The only way to prevent the complete extinction of the last species of wild horse was to reintroduce it into the wild. In 1975, the Dutchman Ian Bouman and his wife, and other entities that joined later, created the Foundation for the Conservation and Protection of the Przewalski Horse (FPPPH), with the aim of saving the Tahki from extinction through acclimatization. of the zoo specimens in open field pastures, for later release into the wild. In 1992, the FPPPH brought the first 15 horses to the Hustain Nuruu area in Mongolia, to reintroduce them to their original habitat. Currently, the population of takhi in the wild in Hustai Nuruu National Park reaches 220 individuals. The practice of taming wild animals and then returning them to the wild is truly rare. Visit to a small museum, about the history of the Hustain Nuruu National Park, about the founders, and the reintroduction of the Przewaslki or Takhi wild horses in their original habitat. Excursion through the interior of the Hustain Nuruu National Park, exploration and observation of wild horses (*bring binoculars). Overnight in Tourist Gers Camp. (B)(L)(D)













Day 4-Breakfast. Then heading to **Elsen Tasarkhai Dunes (known as the Bayangobi Desert**, approx. 180km/112miles, 3-4 hours drive), desert sand dunes spread over 80kms in a beautiful valley. Opportunity for hiking, walking through the dunes, and photographing the landscapes. We will visit an authentic nomadic family with Bactrian camel farms. One hour of excursion included to











ross the dunes on the back of a Bactrian camel. Then, departure to the **Khugnu Khan Peak Nature Reserve** (approx. 15.2km/10 miles, 30 min)-it is a Peak of 1967 meters, with hiking possibilities, and walks to a small function **temple 'Uvgun'**, destroyed in the year 1660. The temple was reopened in 1992 and is currently served by two monks from Ulaanbaatar. Return (approx. 15.2km/10 miles, 30 min). **At sunset we can admire a beautiful sunset over the dunes.** Overnight in Tourist Gers Camp. **(B)(L)(D)**



Day 5-Breakfast. Return to Ulaanbaatar (about 280km/123miles, 4-5 hours drive, depending on the traffic at the entrance to Ulaanbaatar). Latest purchases of Mongolian souvenirs and pure Mongolian cashmere. Transfer to the hotel (*the rooms can be used after 2:00 p.m. on the day of arrival). Overnight at hotel. (B)(L)

Day 6-Breakfast. The rooms must be vacated before **12 noon** on the day of departure. Meeting with Samar Magic Tours at the hotel reception. Transfer to Ulaanbaatar New Airport. **Departure Mongolia (B). Tour Ends.**

INCLUDED SERVICES:


